If you plan on participating in our CIT program there will be a mandatory parent/child meeting on Wednesday, June 5 from 6:00 pm - 7:00 pm.

On the same night, we will also have a CIT training meeting without parent from 7:00 pm - 9:00 pm.

What is a Counselor in Training?

The Counselor in Training or CIT is a vital part of the summer camp program. A CIT is someone who is responsible and eager to learn valuable leadership skills. A CIT is a good role model for campers and enjoys working with children. The objective of the program is to help young teens gain the necessary leadership skills needed to become an effective future camp counselor and/or leader.

CIT's DAY at a GLANCE

CIT's will be assigned a camp group and counselor to assist weekly. Camp begins promptly at 8:30 am. It is important to arrive on time to greet the campers. The camp day is divided into activity periods, which include sports skills, playground games, arts and crafts, structured exercise programs and free swim in our indoor pool. CIT's will assist Kidsports Staff in these different activity periods. Kidsports Summer Camp is designed around weekly themes such as Wacky week, USA week, Sports week, Super Hero week, Pirate week, Princess & Knights week, Science week, Mystery week, Carnival week, and Camp Rewind week. Most weeks include on site and/or off site, events which the CIT's will be able to participate in.

CIT's will convene weekly to discuss and learn appropriate skills needed to be a successful counselor/leader. They will be evaluated on their progress and given helpful pointers on how to be a successful role model.

CIT's must commit to a minimum of 4 weeks and must be available 8:30 am to 4:30 pm each day. We have limited CIT spots.

Parents must pay for this program. CIT program costs are \$115 per week and a non-refundable registration fee of \$40 per child or \$50 per family. Before Care and Aftercare are available at an additional fee of \$20 per family, per week. CIT's are welcome to come on our field trips but an additional \$25 fee will apply.
